Flexible...The Skit Script is written for a 3 day program, but you can break up the script based upon the days and schedule of your Roman's Surrender To Service

- Page 1 -

FIRST NIGHT - OPENING SCENE

GPS walks out from the back toward the U.S.S. Antioch.

GPS - (Talking to kids) "Who was here last year and went on a road trip?"

After kids say Roman... Roman walks out from the back toward GPS.

Roman - "I am SO glad I'm saved!!!"

GPS - "I am so glad that you are saved too, Roman! Tell us again what happened!"

Roman - "The Lord started dealing with my heart, and he showed me that I was not saved while on that road trip, and You showed me from the Bible how I could be saved!

First thing I did was:

ADMIT that I was a Sinner

Romans 3:23 (KJV)

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; "

Then I had to **BELIEVE** on the Lord Jesus Christ to save me.

Romans 10:9 (KJV)

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

I then realized I needed to **CONFESS** my sins and call on the Lord to save me!

Romans 10:13 (KJV)

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

GPS - "I am so excited for you Roman!! Now that you are saved, the Bible says you are a new creature in Christ."

2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV)

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."

Roman - "Wow! I'm a new creature in Christ! I want to live for Him!"

GPS - "You are Roman! Roman, God has commands that He wants you to follow and surrender your life for Him! Roman, I want you to meet The Commander. He will help you as you surrender your life to the Lord! Let's let these kids have some fun, and come back here to the ship in a little bit. The Commander will be waiting on you!"



CLOSING SCENE

Roman enters from the back looking for The Commander...asking the children if they have seen him. The Commander is waiting for Roman at the U.S.S. Antioch.

Roman - "Umm, excuse me, I'm looking for The Commander...have you seen him?"

The Commander - "Are you Roman?"

Roman - "Yes sir, I am!"

The Commander - "GPS told me that you would be coming today. It is good to meet you!"

Roman - "It is good to meet you too, sir! I appreciate you helping me Commander! I want to Live my life for Christ!"

The Commander - "That is so good to hear, Roman! First things first... God's first command is to be saved. The Bible says in:

1 John 3:23 (KJV)

"And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment."

You must **ADMIT** that you are a sinner.

Romans 3:23 (KJV)

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; "

Romans 6:23 (KJV)

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

You must also **BELIEVE** on the Lord Jesus Christ to save you!

Romans 10:9 (KJV)

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

You must **CONFESS** and call upon the Lord!

Romans 10:9-10 (KJV)

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

Romans 10:13 (KJV)

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Roman, Are you saved? If you died right Now, do you know that you know that you will go to Heaven?"



Roman - "Yes sir! I sure am! No doubt in my mind! I knew I was a sinner and I prayed and asked the Lord to come into my heart and save me, and I know He did!"

The Commander - "That is wonderful, Roman. This is the first step as we follow the Commands of Christ! There is no greater decision that you will ever make than the decision to ask the Lord to come into your heart to save you! Tomorrow I will show you the next command to follow."

SECOND NIGHT - OPENING SCENE

The Commander is at the U.S.S. Antioch. Roman walks in from the back.

The Commander - "It's good to see you again, Roman. Are you ready to explore another one of God's Commands?"

Roman - "Yes sir! Commander, I am so excited to grow in my relationship with Christ!"

The Commander - "Roman, after we are saved... we need to surrender our Lives to Christ! Do you know what it means to surrender, Roman?"

Roman - "To be honest, I'm not sure, Commander!"

The Commander - "Where salvation is giving your heart to Christ, surrender is giving your life to the Lord! This means totally surrendering your life to what ever God would have you do!

The Bible says in:

Romans 12:1-2 (KJV)

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

God has a plan for you Roman, but remember that He will not force anyone, So we must surrender our lives to Him, and place our lives in His hands!"

Roman - "Commander, I'm not sure if I am ready to give my whole life and future to the Lord! I have big plans for my life! I don't know if I can trust the Lord with my life."

The Commander - "Roman, there is no greater peace than placing your life in God's hands! Let's meet back here in a little bit and we will talk about this some more!"



CLOSING SCENE

The Commander - "Roman, have you thought any more about surrendering your whole life to Christ?"

Roman - "Yes Sir, I have...But Commander, I have friends that are asking me to go to parties where there is drinking and other bad things. Am I going to miss out on the fun things in life if I surrender my life to God?"

The Commander - "Roman, I understand the struggles and the pressure to do things and go places that you should not go. But remember Roman, you are saved, you are a new creature in Christ, a child of God! Roman you are not going to miss out on any fun of life if you surrender to God, you will only miss out on heartaches and pain!"

The Bible says in:

James 1:14-15 (KJV)

"But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death."

Roman - "I do want to live my life for God, Commander, but sometimes it gets really hard to say no to my friends when they want to go and do bad things!"

The Commander - "I know Roman, but to be honest with you, if they were really your friends... they would not want you to go do bad things!"

Roman - "You are right, Commander. I really do want to surrender my life to the Lord, and give Him all my life, not just part of it... but all of it. I want Him to use me in a great way! Can you pray with me Commander, I want to surrender my life to Christ right now!"

The Commander - "Yes, Roman, I sure will! Let's pray!"

Commander prays as he feels led.



THIRD NIGHT - OPENING SCENE

The Commander is at the U.S.S. Antioch. Roman enters from the back talking to kids first.

Roman - "I am so excited everybody! I am saved and now I have totally surrendered my life to the Lord! I can't hardly wait to see how God will use me!"

The Commander - "Roman, I am so excited for you too! I can tell you, you will never regret those decisions for the Lord. And I have no doubt that God will use you in a great way! And that leads us to the next command, Roman...Service!"

As we already know, the first command was Salvation! The second command was Surrender and now we'll look at the third command, Service."

Roman - "Commander I'm not sure I understand...does God want me to enlist in His Service?"

The Commander - "That's right Roman. God's desire is not only for us to be saved, but He wants us to totally surrender to Him and be in His Service!"

Roman - "What does that mean? Be in His Service?"

The Commander - "I'm so glad you asked that, Roman. God says in His Word that we are to be sharing the Gospel!"

Mark 16:15 (KJV)

"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature."

Roman, I'm sure you know some people that are not saved... wouldn't it be great if they were to get saved?

Romans 10:17 (KJV)

"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

Roman - "Yes sir, I do, and I want to see them saved and surrendered to God!"

The Commander - "Roman, why don't we pray for them right now!"

Commander prays as he feels led.



THIRD NIGHT - CLOSING SCENE

Roman - "Commander, how do I tell my friends about the Lord?"

The Commander - "Roman, first they need to see Christ in you! Allow Christ to live through you!

Next, share with them your testimony... your story of how you realized you were a sinner and how Christ saved you! Tell them how He has changed your Life!

GPS told me awhile back, that you were so lost on your road trip and God saved you!"

Roman - "I sure was Commander! I think I can share my story!"

The Commander - "Roman, there is also another way to share with them. Gospel tracts are a great way to witness to people, especially when you aren't able to have a conversation with them. Here Roman, put these in your pocket and hand these out to people! You can give these to anyone!"
The Commander hands Roman several Gospel Tracts... he could even explain to the children what they are and how God's Word is on them so that people can know how to be saved.

Roman - "This is great, I'm going to go right now to give this to someone I know, and I'm going to share my testimony with him!"

A friend of Roman's is off to the side and Roman goes over to share the Gospel with them. No words are heard, but the children can see how Roman walks his friend through the tract, and shares his story. The friend listens intently and then bows his head and prays on his own to ask the Lord to save him. Roman hugs his friend, then goes back to find The Commander at the U.S.S. Antioch.

Roman - "Commander! Commander! My friend just got saved!"

The Commander - "That is so wonderful, Roman! God has great plans for you! Keep your heart open to Him and listen as He guides your heart and life through His Word! Don't stop here, Roman. You can be a witness for the Lord everyday!"

Roman - "I pray that God will use my life to see many people saved for His glory!"
